## IGP Hosts First Post-Harvest Fumigation course

The IGP Post-Harvest Fumigation School: Applying the Science of Fumigation course was held at IGP on June 9–10, bringing together grain industry professionals and licensed commercial applicators to learn about the latest practices in protecting stored grain and food facilities. Over the two-day course, participants explored new fumigation products, updated application methods, and industry trends aimed at improving grain quality while maintaining safe and effective operations.

Throughout the course, presenters covered important topics such as fumigation planning, monitoring, and record keeping, helping participants better understand how these practices contribute to successful treatments and compliance with industry standards. Attendees also learned about new products and technologies that are becoming available within the fumigation industry.

The course provided plenty of opportunities for participants to ask questions, share their own experiences, and learn from both instructors and fellow attendees. These discussions allowed participants to

gain practical ideas and hear how others are addressing similar challenges in their own operations. The afternoon sessions were hands on demonstrations of the newest equipment and most effective techniques.

By the end of the program, participants left with new knowledge they can apply to their own fumigation businesses or grain storage operations. Courses like this help IGP continue its mission of providing practical education and connecting industry professionals with the resources they need to support safe, effective grain storage.
