

CONFERENCE CENTER OVERVIEW



The IGP Conference Center is located on Kimball Avenue and is one of four buildings in the Grain Science and Industry Complex at Kansas State University. The \$4 million building was dedicated in 2004 with the help of three major contributors: the Kansas Wheat Commission, Kansas Corn Commission and Kansas Soybean Commission. The nearly 20,000 square foot building provides world-class meeting areas and instructional facilities.

HISTORY:

IGP was established in 1978 at the request of the Kansas wheat, corn, grain sorghum and soybean commissions. The Kansas Legislature provided funds to establish the program and these funds are augmented with funds from Kansas commissions. IGP is housed in Kansas State University's Department of Grain Science and Industry. It was built upon international training programs the department started conducting in 1961.
