IGP Hosts IAOM–KSU Introduction to Flour Milling

On April 21–25, IGP hosted the IAOM–KSU Introduction to Flour Milling short course. This course was designed for individuals working in the milling industry and provided them with an overview of the flour milling process, from wheat receiving to finished product distribution.

In this course, participants learned the principles of milling, the impact of wheat quality on milling outcomes, and the characteristics of various wheat varieties and their end products. It also covered flour functionality, baking performance, and the equipment used in the milling process.

Participants gained hands-on experience through workshops in the Hal Ross Flour Mill and the tabletop Milling Lab and Bake Lab in Shellenberger Hall. These exercises offered the opportunity to apply classroom knowledge in a practical setting, allowing participants to explore the differences in wheat varieties and how their characteristics affect the production process.
