Participants in the IAOM–KSU Introduction to Flour Milling course learn the basics of flour milling by grinding wheat into flour using the tabletop mills in Shellenberger Hall.

## IAOM and IGP Provide an Introduction to Flour Milling

The first IGP course of 2023 was the IAOM–KSU Introduction to Flour Milling training held January 9–13 for 17 participants representing Canada, St. Vincent and the Grenadines, and the United States.

The intro course is designed for recent mill employees, HR staff, and management personnel who are new to the milling industry. It provides a general understanding of the principles of the milling process from wheat receiving to finished product distribution.

Participants learn hands-on beginning with smallscale tabletop milling equipment and progressing to the baking lab where they experience how various types of flour can affect baking performance and the final results of baked products. They receive an overview of the equipment used in the milling process and see it in use inside the Hal Ross commercial flour mill. Classroom topics also include learning about the various classes of U.S. wheat, wheat production, supply and demand, the U.S. milling industry, and the principles of how the grain and flour flow through the system during the milling process.
