High Demand Prompts Second Feed Manufacturing Course

The IGP Institute followed up the busy month of June with a second offering of the IGP-KSU Feed Manufacturing Course. An additional 22 industry professionals participated in the course held June 30–July 3, 2025.

High demand for the course led by Carlos Campabadal created an opportunity to host back-to-back sessions of the popular training during the last week of June and the first week of July. A total of 58 participants attended during those weeks.

Topics for the course included grain storage and pest control, particle size reduction, batching and mixing, extrusion, drying and cooling, the effect of feed processing on animal nutrition, pelleting, cooling and crumbling, feed and ingredient handling, feed plant design, energy conservation in the feed mill, steam generation systems, and molds and mycotoxins.

The course is designed to educate feed mill employees and managers of livestock, poultry, and agriculture facilities on ways to enhance the overall performance and safety of their businesses.

The course features lectures from university faculty and industry experts, along with a tour of the K-State O.H. Kruse Feed Technology and Innovation Center, and an extrusion lab demonstration in the Bioprocessing and Industrial Value-Added Products (BIVAP) Innovation Center.
