

# Learning on Location

## Haselwood Farm • Berryton, Kansas



### Learn about a soybean farm that is often a stop for visitors of the IGP Institute.

Heading East of Manhattan near the state capitol, Bob Haselwood, Berryton, Kansas, owns and operates his farm that primarily produces soybeans but grows corn and wheat, as well. He is also often a farm stop for visitors to the IGP Institute.

The three-generation farm hosted 38 participants from the Central and South American and Caribbean regions during the U.S. Soybean Export Council's Oilseeds and Grains Purchasing Resources and Tools program in 2017. These participants learned about Kansas soybean production and were also able to tour the farm. During their visit, the group learned about Haselwood's operation and the production methods that he uses to sustain the diverse crops and improve production yields each year.

Haselwood says that he and his family continually look for different methods to approach their farming tasks and apply those methods to make improvements on the operation. "We really enjoy showing visitors our farm and how we grow our crops in a sustainable way with the technology and equipment that we have."
